

Pair arrested on OxyContin suspicion

WAVERLY — Waverly Police Saturday arrested a man and woman returning from Columbus after having allegedly purchased more than 80 OxyContin pills.

According to information from Waverly Police Chief Larry Roe, Heather Leigh Hren, 24, and David Perry Burton, 22, both of Portsmouth, were arrested after a patrolman stopped the vehicle being operated by Hren and charged her with driving under suspension.

During the stop, 86 40-milligram OxyContin doses were reportedly found in Hren's purse, and the pair were charged with felony possession of drugs. Both are now at the Ross County Jail awaiting a court appearance.
