Dear Ms. Aeh:

Because your community is certified to regulate certain cable service rates, we have enclosed a copy of FCC Form 1205, the form related to our equipment and installation charges.

This will also serve as the required 90 days notice of our intention to change the rate we charge for equipment and installation, effective January 1, 2008. Based on information currently available, the maximum permitted digital converter rate will decrease by \$0.45 (from \$7.66 to \$7.21); the maximum permitted non-addressable converter rate will increase by \$0.05 (from \$0.25 to \$0.30); the maximum permitted remote control rate will decrease by \$0.01 (from \$0.32 to \$0.31); the maximum permitted cable card rate will increase by \$0.37 (from \$2.73 to \$3.10); and the hourly service charge (HSC) will increase from \$42.96 to \$48.56. The standard installation charges are based on the average time required to perform these installations and the HSC.

We anticipate changes in rates for other services in the next few months, and we will provide you with at least 30 days notice of any rate changes.

It includes installation or replacement of a splitter or directional coupler, installation of correct connectors for all cables at the splitter or directional coupler, properly securing the cable to the wall, subfloor, or ceiling, installation of a wall plate and installation of a barrel at the wall plate.

Average Hours per Additional Connection Installation Requiring Separate Installation - This includes installation of a new outlet as described in the TWC Installation Training Manual during a separate truck trip. It is for new or replaced outlets only. It includes installation or replacement of a splitter or directional coupler, installation of correct connectors for all cables at the splitter or directional coupler, properly securing the cable to the wall, subfloor, or ceiling, installation of a wall plate and installation of a barrel at the wall plate.
